Gulf States Utilities (GSU) filed on September 24, 1985, an application for an amendment to Facility Operating License NPF-40, pursuant to 10CFR50.90. As discussed with your Staff, the second paragraph of the "No Significant Hazards Evaluation" in Item I of Enclosure 1 is hereby revised to read as follows:

"Since the proposed amendment does not change any previously reviewed and approved description or analysis described in the FSAR, the proposed amendment does not create the possibility of a new or different kind of accident. Finally, GSU concludes that the proposed change does not involve a significant reduction in a margin of safety because there will be no changes in the availability, operability or reliability of the HPCS diesel generator system."

The Regional Administrator of Region IV, the Senior Resident Inspector and the State of Louisiana, Department of Environmental Quality - Nuclear Energy Division have been provided copies of this revision.




