Dear Ms. Varricchio and Mr. Devine:

This is in partial response to your letter dated February 6, 1985, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), six categories of documents regarding the Wolf Creek Generating Station STN-50-482.

The documents listed on the enclosed Appendix A and a portion of the document listed on the enclosed Appendix B are being placed in the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Public Document Room (PDR) located at 1717 H Street, NW, Washington DC 20555. You may obtain access to these records by presenting a copy of this letter to the PDR staff or by requesting PDR folder FOIA-85-101 under your name.

A portion of the document listed on Appendix B and the documents listed on the enclosed Appendix C are being withheld pursuant to the exemptions cited next to the descriptions of the documents listed on the appendices.

Information being withheld pursuant to Exemption (6) consists of a home address and telephone number and other identifying information. Because disclosure of this information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, it is being withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Exemption (6) of the FOIA (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(6)) and 10 CFR 9.5(a)(6) of the Commission's regulations.

The document being withheld pursuant to Exemption (7)(A) is an investigatory record compiled for law enforcement purposes and is being withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Exemption (7)(A) of the FOIA (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(A)) and 10 CFR 9.5(a)(7)(i) of the Commission's regulations, because disclosure of the information would interfere with an enforcement proceeding.


Pursuant to 10 CFR 9.9 of the NRC's regulations, it has been determined that the information withheld is exempt from production or disclosure, and that its production or disclosure is contrary to the public interest. The persons responsible for this denial are the undersigned and Mr. Robert D. Martin, Regional Administrator, Region IV.

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This denial may be appealed to the NRC's Executive Director for Operations within 30 days from the receipt of this letter. As provided in 10 CFR 9.11, any such appeal must be in writing, addressed to the Executive Director for Operations, U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555, and should clearly state on the envelope and in the letter that it is an "Appeal from an Initial FOIA Decision."

The staff is continuing to search and review records subject to your request. We will notify you as soon as possible with regard to the remaining records.
