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

Dear Judge Wolfe:

This is a progress report on the Licensee's efforts to deal with the spent nuclear fuel accumulated at its Surry Power Station.

The Department of Energy has now accepted 12 of the Licensee's spent nuclear fuel assemblies and has shipped them to the DOE facility in Idaho. This particular shipping campaign will continue until nine additional spent nuclear fuel assemblies have been accepted and delivered to the Idaho facility and the first dry storage cask has been filled. In addition, the Licensee has begun construction of the dry cask storage facility at its Surry Power Station. NRC has not yet issued a license for the facility.
