

EVALUATION OF J. GAGLIARDO'S PERFORMANCE ON THE WATERFORD 3 TEAM

Mr. Gagliardo was asked to serve as the Region IV contact on the Waterford 3 team. At the request of the Task Manager and on his own initiative he went beyond that assignment. An example of that is the issue tracking system he initiated and implemented. This assured that all items are being examined and resolved. He reviewed each of the work plans and modified them as necessary. These revisions substantially improved the plan by focusing the issue and helping to assure closure of the issue. He promptly resolved those administrative problems that could adversely affect the program. He assured that the NRC and consultant resources were being used in the most effective manner by shifting them as necessary to make the most use of their time and available manpower.

He routinely kept the Task Manager and NRC management aware of the ongoing site activities. Briefings were concise and informative. Policy problems were promptly raised to Task Management.

He carried out those tasks he was assigned to do along with those he assumed in a professional and exemplary manner.

Larry Shao was asked to serve as a team leader for the Waterford effort. He was assigned a piping/mechanical team and a civil/structural team. He was responsible for assessing the issues, especially allegations, developing a work plan to examine the validity, safety significance, etc, and implementing that program. His teams were composed of NRR, IE, Regional, RES and consultant personnel. Mr. Shao carried out his assignments in an outstanding manner. He made very effective use of his resources. His assignments were carried out efficiently. He looked into the generic and safety implications and was able to make clear and concise technical judgements on them. His team remained focused on the issues and worked well to bring the issues to a closure.

Overall his performance for this special assignment has been outstanding.
