Randolph R. Ross, Harding Lawson Associates Office Manager, has appointed me Radiation Safety Officer and asked me to supply the following information regarding deficiencies in our application for a license to operate a Troxler Model 3411 Nuclear Density Gauge.

1. Dennis N. Roe has been appointed company Radiation Safety Officer for Alaska. He completed a training course conducted by Troxler Laboratories on October 12, 1982.
2. Randolph R. Ross and Jay M. England have been given refresher training including operating and emergency procedures.
3. Harding Lawson Associates intends to move the gauge from our warehouse at 1716 East 57th Avenue to our leased office/laboratory building at 601 East 57th Place. The gauge will be kept in a storage room between the lab and office that is always kept locked. Only four keys access this door. The storage room has no windows and is located within the wood and masonry office/laboratory complex. The complex is locked during off-duty hours and has an electronic security system installed.
