Florida Power Corporation (FPC) is submitting this response in accordance with NRC Generic Letter 85-06 dated April 16, 1985 (3N0485-24).

FPC will install non-safety-related equipment as required in Section 50.62(d) of the ATWS rule consistent with the B&W Owners Group ATWS Committee document titled "Design Requirements for DSS (Diverse Scram System) and AMSAC (ATWS Mitigation System Actuation Circuitry)". This document will be submitted to you directly from B&W on or about October 1, 1985.

FPC requests a timely NRC review of the BWOOG ATWS Committee document as requested in its submittal letter.

Based upon this timely acceptance, the schedule for the installation of this equipment is Refuel VI, which is presently scheduled for Spring 1987.
