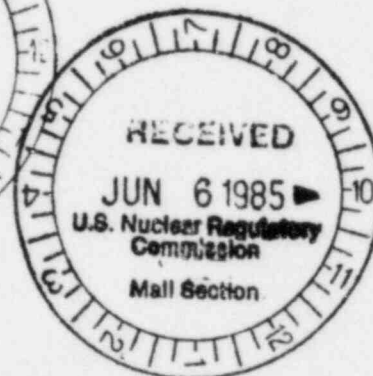
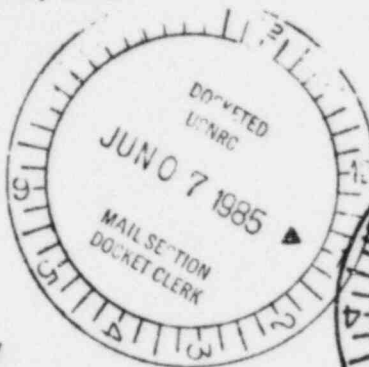

Dear Mr. Shaffer:

On Friday, May 31, 1985, I met with Mr. Jim Finley in his office and discussed the status of the Restoration/Stabilization of the Ruth ISL Research and Development Project (RD 9). The reason for the discussion was to determine the next step in the project, since the first split samples were taken on May 23, 1985.

During that discussion, several other items came out that UUS would like to have clarified as soon as possible, since they all pertain to the question "of what's the next step?"

1. Reference Memo dated March 26, 1985.

As discussed in Mr. Finley's office, UUS would like to have clarification as to (a) the statistics used to determine the baseline numbers in the table attached, and (b) substitute a value in place of the "+"s within that table. This may require a separate table, but it would be helpful to have a number, rather than a statistical "+".

2. Stabilization period.
3. Data necessary to determine STABILIZATION.

Again, this request is made to clarify these points, and it would be helpful to receive comment as soon as possible.


