Thank you for the submittal of the additional information we requested in our letter of July 3, 1985 regarding Revision 10 of the Nuclear Quality Assurance Program. Subsequent discussions between Mr. Dodds and Mr. Wagner of this office with members of your staff regarding your letter of August 16, 1985 resulted in our request for additional clarification concerning Revision 10. Your letter of September 16, 1985 addressed these concerns.

We have reviewed the changes submitted and find that Revision 10, as amended by your letters of August 16 and September 16, 1985, to the Nuclear QA Program continues to satisfy the requirements of 10 CFR 50, Appendix B, and is therefore acceptable. We appreciate your timely submittal of the information required by 10 CFR 50.54(a).
