Gentlemen:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 31 to your NRC License No. 13-06009-01 in accordance with your request.

Please be advised that if you intend to transfer radioactive material between your hospitals you must establish and submit procedures for safely handling radioactive material during transportation. For guidance refer to the enclosed "Transfer of Radioactive Materials Between NRC Licensed Facilities."

At this time we have not authorized the use of Group VI sealed sources at Community Hospital of Indianapolis-North. In order to obtain this authorization you must submit a description of the storage facilities and equipment available at this location.

Please note that we have not authorized Dr. M.F. Mullinix for use of radioactive material at this time. In order to be added, he must submit a completed Supplement A, Training and Experience form. For a copy of this form refer to the enclosed Regulatory Guide 10.8. For required training refer to Appendix A of Regulatory Guide 10.8. In addition, he must specify the total number of hours received in clinical radioisotope training on Supplement B, item 3 Preceptor Statement. To be added for use of Group III, he must document experience eluting a Mo99/Tc99m generator at least five times and preparing at least 5 reagent kits.

Concerning the training Dr. Andrea Browne will provide to bone mineral analyzer users, please be aware that the course as described in letter dated May 10, 1985 does not include instructions on the use of the device itself, i.e. device specific training. Individuals who complete the course must supplement their training by obtaining this device specific training.

Information submitted in response to this letter should state that it is additional information and not a new amendment request.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. You must conduct your program involving radioactive materials in accordance with the conditions of your NRC license, representations made in your license application, and NRC regulations. In particular, note that you must:

1. Operate in accordance with NRC regulations 10 CFR Part 19, "Notices, Instructions and Reports to Workers; Inspections," 10 CFR Part 20, "Standards for Protection Against Radiation," and other applicable regulations.

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2. Possess radioactive material only in the quantity and form indicated in your license.
3. Use radioactive material only for the purpose(s) indicated in your license.
4. Notify NRC in writing of any change in mailing address.
5. Request and obtain appropriate amendment if you plan to change ownership of your organization, change locations of radioactive material, or make any other changes in your facility or program which are contrary to your license conditions or representations made in your license application and any supplemental correspondence with NRC. Any amendment request should be accompanied by the appropriate fee specified in 10 CFR Part 170.
6. Submit a complete renewal application with proper fee or termination request at least 30 days before the expiration date on your license. You will receive a reminder notice approximately 90 days before the expiration date. Possession of radioactive material after your license expires is a violation of NRC regulations.
7. Request termination of your license if you plan to permanently discontinue activities involving radioactive material prior to your expiration date.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions and representations in your license application will result in enforcement action against you in accordance with the General Policy and Procedures for NRC Enforcement Actions, 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C.
