Louisiana Power & Light Company is submitting this letter to verify that all the requirements stipulated in License Condition #16 of the Waterford 3 Facility Operating License No. NPF-38 have been satisfied prior to the completion of Phase III of the Waterford 3 Startup Test Program.

The following measures have been implemented to support closure of each subsection of the subject License Condition:

- A) A Comprehensive Audit of the Operational Quality Assurance Program was performed by Middle South Services on April 15-19, 1985 and the results of the audit indicate that LP&L meets the requirements of License Condition #16A.
- B) Course Q100-600-00, "QA Lessons Learned" in video tape format was developed and presented to Waterford 3 employees and an abbreviated version of this tape is being presented in the Introductory Course to General Employee Training, thereby meeting the requirements of License Condition #16B.
- C) The response to address each of the recommendations to the NUS Limited Scope Audit Report has been formally submitted, thereby meeting the requirements of License Condition #16C.
- D) Completion of all the corrective actions related to the 23 NRC Issues as identified in the LP&L responses, has been satisfied, thereby meeting the requirements of License Condition #16D.


