
Dear Mr. Madera:

On May 23, 1985, we transferred U.S. Radium Model Lab 508-1 tritiated foil source to the University of Akron under the assumption they were licensed to possess this material and requested a termination of our license, No. 34-09836-01.

We now understand that the University of Akron was not licensed to receive this material and have subsequently received your June 7th letter. It is our understanding that the University of Akron has advised your agency of this matter and that they have the source in a locked and secure place. We have been advised by the radiation safety officer for the University of Akron that they have applied for an amendment to their license, No. 34-03279-03, which will permit them to retain possession of this material and that they have received an acknowledgement of receipt of the application.

We regret the misunderstanding relative to this matter and respectfully request that you terminate our license upon the approval of the amendment requested by the University of Akron.
