Dear Ms. Grossberg:

This is the final response to your letter dated August 8, 1985, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 11 categories of records related to Inspection Report No. 50-443/84-12 and 50-444/84-06 for the Seabrook plant.

Copies of the documents listed on the enclosed Appendix B are being placed in the NRC Public Document Room (PDR) in folder FOIA-85-560 under your name.

A July 24, 1984, letter to Commissioner Asselstine from an individual is being withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Exemption 6 of the FOIA (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(6)) and 10 CFR 9.5(a)(6) of the Commission's regulations. Disclosure of this information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 9.15 of the Commission's regulations, it has been determined that the information withheld is exempt from production or disclosure and that its production or disclosure is contrary to the public interest. The person responsible for this denial is Mr. John Hoyle, Assistant Secretary of the Commission.

This denial may be appealed to the Secretary of the Commission within 30 days from the receipt of this letter. Any such appeal must be in writing, addressed to the Secretary of the Commission, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555, and should clearly state on the envelope and in the letter that it is an "Appeal to the Initial FOIA Decision."
