Subject: Communication System Test

On Monday July 15, 1985 at 9:00 AM, Monroe County tested its communication equipment from the Monroe County Emergency Operations Center. The purpose of the test was to verify that critical communications equipment was functioning properly. The test included a check of pagers, monitors, portable radios, emergency telephones, siren encoder, radio consoles and access to Monroe Cablevision.

Pagers and monitors required a call-back to acknowledge message receipt. Radios and telephones required two-way communication to verify that the equipment functioned. Siren rotation was visually verified. Hot line access to Monroe Cablevision was made. Documentation from the county regarding this drill is attached herewith.




