Request for Fees Not Remitted With Applications

Gentlemen:

In your letter dated June 19, 1985 (ØCNAØ685Ø9) you requested that AP&L remit the sum of \$1,750 for fees in connection with our Technical Specification submittal of March 16, 1984 (ØCANØ384Ø1) and the submittal of December 14, 1984 (1CAN1284Ø3) involving steam generator sleeved tube inspection.

As stated in our letter of April 17, 1985 (ØCANØ485Ø3) AP&L does not believe that an additional fee of \$1,600 is appropriate as our March 16, 1984 Technical Specification submittal involved one regulation, one submittal and therefore only one fee, not two fees as you requested.

Additionally, as stated in our letter of May 9, 1985 (ØCANØ585Ø2) we believe only one \$150 application fee should be remitted with our submittals of August 13, 1984 (1CANØ884Ø4) and December 14, 1984. This is due to the fact that both submittals involve the same issue of steam generator tube sleeving. Also, the second submittal was in response to a request by members of the NRC staff.


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However, in view of the fact that you do not agree with our position and in order to bring this issue to a close, remitted is \$1,750.
