
SUBJECT: ASSESSMENT OF NRC REGION II CAREER COUNSELING PROGRAM -
SECOND QUARTERLY REPORT - JUNE - AUGUST, 1982

This memorandum refers to your request to submit a statement on the progress of our Career Counseling Program.

The Region II Career Counseling Program is viewed as a major training activity, and the focus has been on the employee's development of specific skills in self assessment, career decision-making, and goal setting. Comments from participants during this quarter reflect very positive ones, and a feeling of satisfaction in experiencing the counseling process.

The counselor's presentations appear to have enabled the employees to develop more vocational maturity and work satisfaction, greater self-confidence, and an increased awareness of interests and aptitudes. His expertise in career counseling and manner of presentations have established a very positive relationship among the participants.

The program has been well received by the counselees. Although we have designated the minimum 25 nominees for this program, additional nomination forms have been received to enroll in the program.
