Toye Simmons of my staff and Kevin Crouch, Niblock Radiation Safety Officer, discussed this matter by telephone on November 7 and 25, 1996, to ascertain whether Niblock was contesting the violation as written. Based upon your letter dated December 2, 1996, Niblock Excavating, Inc. is not contesting the violation. We have reviewed your corrective actions, which appear to be adequate, and have no further questions at this time. These corrective actions will be examined during a future inspection.
