In accordance with letters dated April 17, 1985 and May 3, 1985, License No. 27-16664-01 is amended as follows:

License Conditions 10., 12., and 17. are amended to read:

10. Licensed materials may be used at the licensee's facilities at 400 Railroad Avenue, Boulder City, Nevada; Phoenix, Arizona; Wellton, Arizona; Yuma, Arizona; Imperial, California; Indio, California; Beardsley, Arizona; Marana, Arizona; Harquahala Valley, Arizona; and at temporary job sites of the licensee anywhere in the United States.

Licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision and in the physical presence of, Val H. Carter, Terry Taylor, Leon Martin or other individuals who have been trained in accordance with procedures contained in application received July 25, 1980 and who have been designated by the Radiation Protection Officer, Stanley Conway.

Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use licensed material described in Items 6, 7, and 8 of this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in application received July 25, 1980; and letters dated November 25, 1980, July 14, 1982, August 24, 1984, December 6, 1984, April 17, 1985 and May 3, 1985. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern the licensee's statements in applications or letters, unless the statements are more restrictive than the regulations.
