SUBJECT: DOCKET NOS. 50-259, 50-260, AND 50-296 BROWNS FERRY NUCLEAR PLANT
RADIOLOGICAL EMERGENCY PLAN REVIEW

We have completed our review of Revisions 16, 17, 19, and 20 of the Browns Ferry Radiological Emergency Plan dated November 8, 1984, November 27, 1984, January 4, 1985, and January 17, 1985, respectively.

Our review indicated that your Browns Ferry Radiological Emergency Plan continues to meet the planning standards of 10 CFR 50.47(b) and the requirements of Appendix E to 10 CFR 50.

Please be reminded that 10 CFR 50.54(q) requires NRC approval of any changes to your plan which decrease its effectiveness. However, if your safety review indicates no decrease in emergency preparedness, then changes can be made without NRC approval. In all cases, you should furnish copies of each change to the NRC in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q). Also, any changes to the Emergency Plan Implementing Procedures should be made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 50, Appendix E, Section V (Implementing Procedures).
