Subject: Inspection Report No. 30-17757/85-01

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Marlene J. Taylor of this office on June 6, 1985 of activities authorized by NRC License No. 37-16507-02 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mrs. Taylor with Dr. Friedman and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector, and observations by the inspector.

During the course of the inspection, the inspector determined that licensed material is received prior to the normal operating hours of the nuclear medicine department. This does not appear to be consistent with item 1 of your August 20, 1984 letter to Dr. Glenn of this office. Please review this matter and determine whether your receipt of licensed materials is consistent with the procedures which have been submitted to the NRC. Please discuss this matter in your reply to this letter. You are advised that requests for changes to your approved procedures should be submitted to this office with the appropriate amendment fee to the USNRC, Nuclear Materials Safety and Safeguards Branch, 631 Park Avenue, King of Prussia, Pennsylvania 19406.

Based on the results of this inspection, it appears that one of your activities was not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements, as set forth in the Notice of Violation, enclosed herewith as Appendix A. This violation has been categorized by severity level in accordance with the revised NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR 2, Appendix C) published in the Federal Register Notice (49 FR 8583) dated March 8, 1984. You are required to respond to this letter and in preparing your response, you should follow the instructions in Appendix A.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and your reply will be placed in the Public Document Room.
