Gentlemen:

This is a follow-up to our meeting with Mr. Jarrett on November 27, 1984, concerning renewal and amendment of License No. 19-0015-03. In the meeting, we discussed your waste disposal program and possible additional amendments related to irradiators.

I informed Mr. Jarrett that we could not grant blanket authorization for the Department of Agriculture to operate commercial burial grounds or incinerators anywhere in the U. S., and that we would need site-specific information. For new incinerators, we also request that DOA get comments from State and local governments. Mr. Jarrett indicated that you would like certain amendments to receive higher priority than the renewal, and that he would submit additional information clarifying your priorities and supporting your requests. No additional information has been received by us to date.

Please be advised that we have delayed any action as your case pending receipt of additional information. If we do not receive the information within 30 days we may proceed with review on the basis of your original application. In that case, we might not be able to give priority to any amendments or approve any significant amendments to your existing license.

Also note that responsibility for your license and most Federal licenses will be transferred to our Region I office on April 1, 1985. All licensees will be officially notified of this transfer soon.

Any correspondence related to your case should be in duplicate and reference Control Nos. 17112 and 17481.
