NOTICE OF VIOLATION

As a result of the inspection conducted on June 6, 1985, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR 2, Appendix C), the following violation was identified:

Condition 20 of License No. 37-16507-02 requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with statements, representations and procedures contained in an application dated April 30, 1980, and letters dated April 17, 1978, January 30, 1984, May 27, 1982, December 17, 1982, March 25, 1983, and August 20, 1984; and Model ALARA Program contained in Appendix O of Regulatory Guide 10.8 (Rev. 1) "Guide for the Preparation of Applications for Medical Programs", October 1980.

Block 7 of the application dated April 30, 1980 requires that the duties of the Medical Isotopes Committee be as outlined in Appendix B of Regulatory Guide 10.8.

Appendix B requires that the medical isotopes committee meet as often as necessary to conduct its business but not less than once in each calendar quarter.

Contrary to the above, as of June 6, 1985, there was only one meeting of the Medical Isotopes Committee in 1983.

This is a Severity Level IV (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, Taylor Hospital is hereby required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of the letter which transmitted this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending this response time.
