Task: Allegation A-177

Characterization: It is alleged that an EBASCO quality assurance (QA) inspector did not exercise proper judgment and may not be doing his job honestly while dispositioning nonconformance reports (NCRs) concerning American Bridge Company steel construction work.

Assessment of Allegation: The allegation has no safety significance since all American Bridge Company (AB) work had been re-inspected after the allegation was made, resulting in discrepancy notices (DNs), two NCRs, and appropriate corrective measures for the work in question. The allexer also stated that he no longer had any concern over AB work. The NRC staff also reviewed the two NCRs addressing this subject and found no questions or concerns.

The integrity of the EBASCO inspector's work is being addressed by the NRC Office of Investigations (OI), which is currently investigating this matter.

The NRC staff is satisfied, based on the review of the NCRs, that the safety issues related to AB have been properly addressed.
