In addition, one inspector has been terminated partly because of falsification of inspection records.

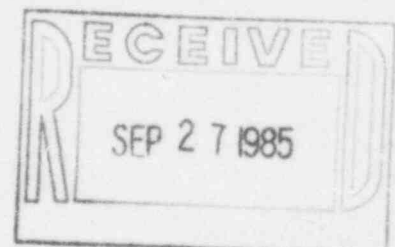
