Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. L. J. Hueter of this office on July 9 through 12, 1985, of activities at Quad Cities Nuclear Power Stations, Units 1 and 2 authorized by NRC Operating Licenses No. DPR-29 and DPR-30 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. Tamlyn and others at the conclusion of the inspection.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.


