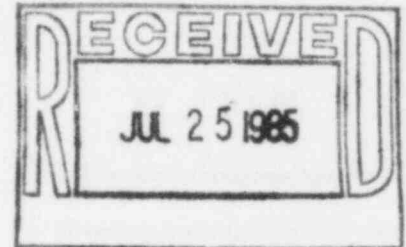

Arkansas Power and Light Company has received your letter of July 3, 1985 regarding our proposed revision to the Emergency Plan and Procedures to resolve the NRC concern over the timely staffing of the Emergency Operations Facility (EOF).

We understand from a telephone conversation between Tom Cogburn of my staff and Richard Bangart of your office that the Program Office of Inspection and Enforcement (Headquarters) fully supports the proposed EOF staffing changes. If this is incorrect, please advise us accordingly. Otherwise, no response to this letter is required.

In your correspondence, particular concern was expressed in being certain*to address (1) the scope of authority that will be delegated to the Emergency Operations Facility Director (EOFD) in our proposal and (2) the provisions


