NOTICE OF VIOLATION

As a result of the inspection conducted on March 19 and 20, 1985, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR 2, Appendix C), the following violation was identified:

Condition 16 of license No. 31-00032-04 requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with the statements, representations and procedures contained in an application dated April 7, 1978.

Block 15 of this application requires that radioactive material be used in accordance with the "Radiation Protection Procedures" attached to the application.

Item 3 of Section 7.8 of these procedures, "Laboratory Rules for the use of Radioactive Materials", requires that persons working with unsealed radioactive materials monitor their hands upon completing operations with the radioactive material.

Contrary to the above, as of March 20, 1985, persons working with unsealed radioactive materials in the Nuclear Medicine Laboratory were not routinely monitoring their hands upon completing operations.

This is a Severity Level IV Violation. (Supplement VI)

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, the Veterans Administration Medical Center is hereby required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of the letter which transmitted this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending this response time.
