Subject: Inspection 80-02

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. J. Nicolosi of this office on April 2, 1980, of activities authorized by NRC License No. 29-15364-01 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Nicolosi with yourself and Mr. Rank of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The area examined during this inspection was limited to a verification of the survey performed by Chem-Nuclear Incorporated in preparation for release of part of your facility for unrestricted use. Within this area, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.

The survey and wipe test evaluation performed by our inspector generally confirms the results obtained by your consultant, Chem-Nuclear Incorporated. The exceptions are those areas identified to you by our inspector on the day of the inspection and in subsequent telephone conversations from this office to you on April 3 and 8, 1980. We understand you plan to further decontaminate these areas and submit an amended survey report to the NRC's Materials Licensing Branch.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and your reply will be placed in the Public Document Room.
