

October 28	Deadline for identifying QA witnesses, except for the safety-related equipment issue (hereinafter "82-05 issue"). QA discovery ends except for deposition of witnesses and discovery generally on 82-05 issue.
October 28	Motions for summary disposition on QA contention (no summary disposition on 82-05 issue).
October 29	Begin hearings on Rorem Contention 1(a).
November 18	Depositions of all witnesses completed except for 82-05 issue.
