

Enclosed please find three (3) copies of the South Texas Project (STP) Unit 1 PSI Examination Plan for steam generator (SG) tube examination entitled "Eddy Current Examination Manual for Houston Lighting & Power Company". As previously discussed with Mr. Martin Hum (MTEB) this PSI examination plan is Houston Lighting & Power Company's (HL&P's) initial plan for examination of steam generator tubing in accordance with 10CFR50.55(a) and ASME Section XI.
