NOTICE OF VIOLATION

As a result of the inspection conducted on August 28, 1985, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR 2, Appendix C), the following violations were identified:

- A. 10 CFR 19.12 requires that all individuals working in a restricted area be instructed in the precautions and procedures to minimize exposure to radiation and radioactive materials, and in the applicable provisions of the Commission's regulations and licenses.

Contrary to the above, as of August 28, 1985, all individuals, including the janitorial staff who work in restricted areas, had not been instructed in the required subjects.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

- B. Condition 17 of License No. 29-19737-01 requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with statements, representations and procedures contained in a number of documents, one of which is a letter dated November 9, 1982.

Item 3 of this letter requires that monthly wipe tests be performed in designated laboratories.

Contrary to the above, as of August 28, 1985, wipe tests were not conducted for February, May, and June, 1985 as required.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, Mobile Oil Corporation is hereby required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of the letter which transmitted this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending this response time.

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
