The subject corporation has not been an active licensee during calendar year 1973 due to financial problems.

Enclosed are letters from the Isomedix Corporation to the Directorate of Licensing and memorandums regarding the Morton Grove facility. The facility was taken over by Isomedix in the summer of 1973 to prepare for licensing. As noted in the correspondence, the 8000 curies of Cobalt 60 owned by the subject licensee will be disposed of when the Cobalt 60 is delivered to the facility for Isomedix. The small sources will be licensed under Isomedix.

According to licensing the Isomedix license to operate the facility will be issued early in January 1974.

A form AEC-314 has been provided to the subject licensee for his completion when the material is disposed of.

I believe this explains the situation at the Morton Grove facility. Copies of applicable information and the license for the facility will be forwarded to your office when received.
