Dear Ms. Reidlinger:

I am in receipt of the above NRC license. The following is in response to your request for additional information.

In addition to the procedures specified for surveying by laboratory personnel after each usage of licensed material, the radiation safety officer will conduct an independent six monthly survey which will include:

1. Review of routine survey records.
2. Audit of all isotopes, and logs.
3. Review of safety procedures and compliance.
4. Survey of work benches, hoods and sinks with a portable geiger counter equipped with a beta probe. Results will be recorded. Areas with counts of more than 10x above background will be checked using the wipe method and decontaminated if necessary.
5. Using the wipe method working areas of benches hoods and sinks will be monitored and results of these checks will be entered. Areas with counts of above 10x background will be decontaminated.
