In order to bring our operation into compliance with our license,  
I propose that the following changes be made in the license.  
Items 6, 7 and 8 will be changed to read as follows:


<u>6</u>	<u>7</u>	<u>8</u>
A. Nickel 63	A. Any NRC approved foil or plated surface in any NRC approved cell.	A. Not to exceed 25 millicuries per foil on plated source.
B. Hydrogen 3	B. Any	B. 50 millicuries
C. Carbon 14	C. Any	C. 200 millicuries

Everything else would remain the same except part 9 which would  
eliminate the H<sub>3</sub> and read as follows:

A. for use in gas chromatograph for sample analysis.  
B. and C. for use in laboratory tracer studies.

I hope this meets with your approval and the license can be amend-  
ed in this fashion.
