There have been no significant changes in our program since our last By-Product Materials License renewal. Our authorized users remain the same, those being:

1. John P. Crotty, M.D.
2. Joseph M. Dugan, M.D.
3. Garry L. Carls, M.D.

John Crotty, M.D. is still the Radiation Safety Officer, with Drs. Dugan and Carls acting as back-ups. The Nuclear Medicine technologist will also act as Assistant R.S.O. in the absence of the R.S.O.

Instrumentation remains essentially the same. The Radiation Safety Committee membership is composed of the required members as listed in 10 CFR 35.

Procedures relating to the use of Xenon 133 remain the same. Air Flow rates remain unchanged from those submitted with the last renewal. Room ventilation air flow rates are checked on a semi-annual basis, as required. The Xenon trap system is monitored on a continual basis, by means of a Xenon trap monitor.

We authorize Mr. Ronald D. Edwards, Physicist, Radiation Protection Consultants, LTD., 4255 Westbrook Drive, Aurora, Illinois, to act on our behalf to answer any questions or provide any additional information you may require, regarding this renewal request, or any future amendment requests.


