Dear Mr. Portugal:

Your letters of May 3 and May 7, 1976 have been referred to me for response.

The code of Federal Regulations, CFR, of which you request numerous parts, is published and distributed by the U.S. Government Printing Office. I enclose a subscription order form for your use. By obtaining a subscription, you will receive all current regulations, the basic manual, and all amendments as they are published. All pages are punched for a notebook and therefore easy to change to keep the manual current.

The Standard Review Plan (SRP) is available from the National Technical Information Service, (NTIS) Springfield, Virginia 22161. I am informed that the price of the SRP mailed to a non-U.S. address is \$75.00. With the purchase of the SRP from NTIS, you will also receive any supplements that are published within one year's time from the date of your purchase of the SRP.

I note that you request several individual regulatory guides. With the exception of two guides, namely 1.70 and 3.39 which must be purchased from NTIS as mentioned above, NRC does distribute the guides free of charge. Our records indicate that Mr. R.J. Palabrica of PAEC is receiving guides published in divisions 1, 5, 7, 8, and 10. Also, Mr. Donato, Chief Librarian, PAEC, is on our distribution list to receive guides in all ten divisions. I would ask you to investigate these potential sources of information before we add another PAEC address to our routine mailing.

It is the desire of NRC to provide information not only to individuals but also to agency libraries where all interested staff may have access to information. May I also take this opportunity to inform you that Mrs. Dativa M. de Guia of PAEC has recently spent approximately 6 months with the NRC office of Executive Legal Director. You may find it helpful to talk

with Mrs. de Guia regarding NRC documents she may have obtained or arranged to receive.

In closing, I would also inform you that most NRC published documents are not protected by copyright nor is Commission approval necessary to reproduce documents; therefore, you and PAEC are permitted to reproduce many of the NRC documents such as the regulatory guides, SRP's, and parts of the CFR.

I trust you will find this information helpful.
