This letter is in response to our telephone conversation today regarding additional information that you need to process our request for an amendment to Precision Castparts' source material License STB 1444.

I have applied for licenses under reciprocity provisions in the agreement states of Maryland and Washington to date, and plan to apply in other states if venders there wish to participate in the project.

I keep a log of all surveys relating to the health physics of each project and collect water samples before and after the project for analysis to insure that no contamination is left at the site. I will gladly provide you with copies at the conclusion of operations at each site if you need them for your files. Since the log contains proprietary information, some of the material not relating to health physics will be edited unless we negotiate a proprietary information agreement.

I requested that the auditing department forward a check for \$120.00 to Glenda Jackson to cover the amendment fee as we discussed, and a copy of the check is enclosed.
