SUBJECT: EXPIRATION OF MATERIALS LICENSE NO. SNM-1999, CUSHING REFINERY SITE

Dear Mr. Lux:

The Kerr-McGee Corporation holds Materials License SNM-1999, which authorizes it to possess enriched uranium in U-235, thorium, natural and depleted uranium, and U-235 for use in calibration or reference radioactive sources. This license was designated to expire on January 1, 1997, if not timely renewed. As Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR), Sections 30.36(c), 40.42(c) and 70.38(c) indicate, this license continues in effect, beyond the expiration date, with respect to the materials licensed, until the Commission notifies a licensee in writing that the license is terminated.

Therefore, Kerr-McGee Corporation should recognize its obligation under its license in accordance with these provisions to limit its actions involving the materials listed on its license to those related to decommissioning and, in addition, continue to control areas until they are suitable for release in accordance with U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) requirements. NRC expects the Kerr-McGee Corporation to continue to comply with the terms of Material License SNM-1999 as amended until the NRC notifies the Kerr-McGee Corporation in writing that the license is terminated.
