Gentlemen:

Please find enclosed Amendment No. 02 to License No. 35-06776-04 extending the expiration date to May 31, 1979.

It is the current policy of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to issue a single license to cover an institution's entire needs for radioactive material (except the large sources used for irradiators). A check of our files indicates that the University of Tulsa currently holds Material License Nos. 35-06776-04 and 35-06776-05 and Special Nuclear Material License No. SNM-957 that should be combined into a single license. Accordingly, before the expiration date of May 31, 1979, the University of Tulsa should submit a complete application in accordance with the enclosed licensing guides combining all of your institution's needs for radioactive material into a single license. Except for training and experience criteria of individual users, this application should be complete without referring to material previously submitted to this office.
