Gentlemen:

This letter requests an amendment to our industrial radiography license 12-00622-07 regarding a change in licensee name (condition 1), addition of approved film badge services (condition 19 by reference), addition of a survey meter calibration service (condition 19 by reference), and the deletion of a location for permanent use and storage of byproduct material (condition 11). The details of our requests are as follows:

1. We request condition 1 of the license change from MAGNAFLUX Corporation to MQS Inspection, Incorporated. The address referenced in condition 2 remains the same. Recently, the MAGNAFLUX Quality Services division of MAGNAFLUX Corporation was formed into a separate legal entity. MQS Inspection, Inc., remains a wholly owned subsidiary of GEO International. Attached is a revised list of the officers and directors of MQS Inspection, Inc., and GEO International. All former and future references to MAGNAFLUX Quality Services in statements, representations, forms and procedures in license 12-00622-07 with attachments should now be deemed as references to MQS Inspection, Inc.
2. 

3. We request approval to utilize Magna-Chek, Inc., NRC license 21-19111-02 to calibrate our survey instruments.
4. We request the deletion of our 3 Harding Place, Little Ferry, New Jersey 07643 facility as a location of byproduct material use and storage from condition 11. All licensed materials formerly in storage and use at our Little Ferry, New Jersey office have been transferred to our other licensed locations. The records have been transferred to 7300 W. Lawrence Avenue and archived. On June 11, 1985, I performed surveys of the Little Ferry offices, laboratory area, exposure cell, and the source storage cabinet. The survey was performed using a Victoreen 493 with 491-40 probe calibrated on May 6, 1985. All areas surveyed displayed background levels.
