TELEPHONE CALL APRIL 24 TO A MR. MORSE FROM THE OFFICE OF CONGRESSMAN  
CHARLES TEAGUE, CALIFORNIA

Mr. Morse had an inquiry from a newspaper man on the limitations for  
the control of waste disposal in the ocean. The general licensing  
procedure and conditions under which sea disposal licenses are issued  
were reviewed very briefly. It was suggested that several applications  
had been received recently and were being acted upon.

to Mr. Morse that an answer was in preparation. However, it could be

hearing.
