Attached please find the Sohio Chemical "Outline of Proposed Plan to Decommission the Vistron Corporation, Lima, Ohio Facility Operated Under USNRC Byproduct Materials License No. SUB-908" and the Sohio Chemical "Radiation Detection and Control Plan for ANI Dismantlement." The first proposal outlines the general approach that Sohio Chemical intends to follow in order to decontaminate the Lima facility and terminate our license. The second proposal offers proposed procedures to be followed during the ANI dismantlement that will occur beginning in early October. It is intended that these procedures be flexible and adjustable depending on the experience during the early decontamination operations.

We seek a timely review of our plan and therefore have planned for our representatives to meet with you in Washington, D.C. on Friday, September 27. As stated in our previous letter to Region 3 of the U.S. NRC, due to safety related concerns regarding asbestos removal, we wish to begin dismantlement of the ANI facility as soon as possible.

Thank you for your consideration of our proposal. We look forward to discussing these issues in detail on September 27.
