Transmittal of Additional Sets of
Revision 1 Emergency Response Guidelines

NRC letter of June 20, 1984 (D. G. Eisenhower to J. J. Sheppard) requested additional information with respect to the Revision 1 version of the Emergency Response Guidelines (ERGs), including five (5) additional Revision 1 ERG sets to aid in the NRC final review and in the docketing and interfacing needs to support this review. Westinghouse Owners Group letter OG-132, dated August 15, 1984 (J. J. Sheppard to D. G. Eisenhower) provided information in response to the NRC requests, stating that additional Revision 1 ERG sets were not available but would be provided after a second printing. This second printing was completed in mid-January 1985.

The purpose of this letter is to provide the additional ERG sets committed in letter OG-132. Enclosed are five high-pressure (HP) sets and five low-pressure (LP) sets. Each set consists of the following six volumes:

- o Executive Volume
- o Guideline Volume
- o Background Volume for E-0 and ECA-0 Guidelines
- o Background Volume for E-1, E-2, ECA-1 and ECA-2 Guidelines
- o Background Volume for E-3 and ECA-3 Guidelines
- o Background Volume for FR-S, FR-C and FR-H Guidelines
- o Background Volume for FR-P, FR-Z and FR-I Guidelines and Status Trees



Sheppard to H. L. Thompson, Jr.) and letter OG-123, dated May 4, 1984 (J. J. Sheppard to H. L. Thompson, Jr.).

The WOG acknowledges receipt of NRC letter of December 27, 1984 (D. G. Eisenhut to J. J. Sheppard) providing preliminary approval of the Revision 1 ERGs. This approval will facilitate efforts by WOG member utilities to develop upgraded emergency operating procedures based on the ERGs and to implement these upgraded EOPs per NUREG-0737 Supplement 1. Your cooperation in providing this preliminary review and approval is appreciated.
