Gentlemen:

We have reviewed your letter dated March 15, 1985 requesting an amendment to your license to add Dr. Kovalsky and find that we will need additional information as follows:

1. Indicate in Item 3 of Supplement B, the dates and total number of hours Dr. Kovalsky has received in clinical radioisotope training as required in Section 2.c of Appendix A of Regulatory Guide 10.8. These hours should be documented on Supplement B, Item 3.
2. Submit documentation of Dr. Kovalsky personal participation in five procedures to elute Tc-99m, including testing eluates, and five procedures to prepare radiopharmaceuticals from Group III reagent kits. These procedures should be documented on a Supplement B form, Item 2, Columns A and C for Mo99/Tc99m generator and Tc99m reagent kits.
