Gentlemen:

This concerns the subject application for material license and to the phone conversation between Dr. Waldron of your staff and Mr. Miller of my staff on March 13, 1985.

Mr. Miller informed Dr. Waldron that Saint Joseph's Byproduct Material License #37-01753-01 had expired per 10 CFR 30.36(c) and that all byproduct material authorized by this license must be placed into storage until a new license is issued.

Mr. Miller requested that the following information be submitted to support your current application:

- (a) The results of the close-out survey performed on Room 108 of the Science Center
- (b) A copy of the instructions to security personnel addressing the receipt provided of incoming packages of radioactive material after normal working hours
- (c) A copy of the general laboratory instructions that includes instructions to students to wear disposable gloves and lab coats when handling radioactive material

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- (d) Specification of the quantities of P-32 that are routinely handled by students
