A. Gavazzi, Medical Center Director; letter with enclosures received May 26, 1982 signed by A. A. Gavazzi, Medical Center Director; letters dated July 29, 1982, January 23, 1984 and September 12, 1985 signed by A. A. Gavazzi, Director; and Section I. (Item I.) and Section II. (Item J.) of Radiation Safety Guide enclosed in letter dated August 9, 1985. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern the licensee's statements in applications or letters, unless the statements are more restrictive than the regulations.
