Dear Mr. Gordon:

This is in further reply to your letter of August 25, 1958. Since acknowledging your letter we have received a letter from Mr. Harry K. Grafe, Executive Secretary, Senate Interim Committee on Fish and Game, Sacramento, California, informing us that a hearing is to be held on October 6 and 7 in San Francisco to discuss the possible effects on marine life of the ocean disposal of radioactive waste from peacetime uses.

We have been in contact with Mr. Ed. C. Johnson, Chairman of the Senate Committee, and have arranged to have members of our staff appear before this Committee during the week of October 20.

In view of the importance and scope of the questions discussed in your letter of August 25 we believe first-hand discussions with you would be more profitable than trying to deal with the questions by letter. If it is agreeable with you we would like to suggest our staff meet with you after the hearing during the week of October 20 on a date that would be convenient with you.

We would hope that these discussions would assist in resolving the problems of disposal of radioactive waste in the Pacific Ocean. We shall look forward to hearing from you as to whether such a meeting is agreeable.
