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


Subj: Applications for Renewal

Enclosed are applications for renewal of material license number 11-18311-01, for Boise VAMC. This application differs from our present institutional license only with regard to (1) relocation of the in-vitro radioassay laboratory facility, and (2) expansion of the radionuclide work area within the research laboratory. Please note that we are again requesting a 20 millicurie possession limit for tritium, in order to obtain the benefit of bulk purchase of tritium labelled assay kits.
