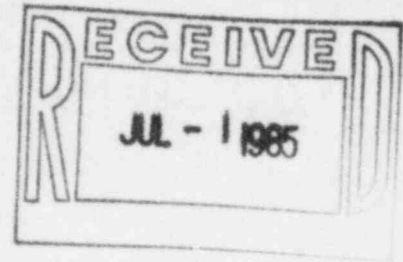

The additional information you requested is as follows:

1. Permanent storage facilities are located at 902 13th St.,
Cody, WY 82414.
2. Training provided to other users.
 - a. Each employee will complete the device manufacturer's training program before being permitted to use the device, or an alternate training course, as provided by Nuclear Testing Service, Salt Lake City, Utah. This course includes discussion of radiological safety and gauge operation taught by Don Muir.
 - b. Records documenting the training of each employee will be maintained for two (2) years from the date of training completion.
3. Film Badges

4. Storage building is a permanently-constructed wood frame building (12' x 15'). It has a single access door which will be locked at all times.
5. Only employees with the necessary training for handling and use of the nuclear device will be allowed access to this storage area. Unauthorized persons will not be allowed access. Unauthorized removal from storage will be prevented by locking the area at all times.
