Subject: Catawba Nuclear Station, Units 1 and 2 - Transmittal of a Draft
Technical Evaluation Report (TER) on Regulatory Guide 1.97,
Revision 2, Generic Letter 82-33

By letter dated September 26, 1983, you responded to Generic Letter 82-33 (Supplement 1 to NUREG -0737) regarding the Catawba Station conformance to R.G. 1.97, Rev. 2. The enclosed draft TER was prepared by our contractor, Idaho National Engineering Laboratory, after having reviewed the applicable portions of your response to the Generic Letter. The draft TER concludes that, for some items, your justification for exceptions to R.G. 1.97 is acceptable. However, there are items for which the staff and its contractor could not conclude that adequate justification was provided.
