Enclosed you will find in duplicate Form NRC-313(I) which has been completed to amend our radioactive materials license. Also enclosed is our check in the amount of \$110.00 to cover the amendment fee. The changes we request are as follows:

- Item #5: Please add a new facility now under construction at Woodward, Oklahoma. There is no street address, as this location is outside the city limits on Section Line Road. See attached drawing and bunker design.
- Item #6: We request that you give our Radiation Protection Officer the authority to designate radiation handlers after completion of the radiation safety training. This in-house training program will alleviate the need to have individuals named on our license and the amending of our license every time there is a change in personnel. Instructor for our company at present is Keith E. Moon of Support Consultants & Associates, Inc.
- Item #7: Please change our Radiation Protection Officer to L. D. "Chuck" Robertson. His resume is attached. As you will note, he has served in this capacity for other well logging companies and is familiar with the duties and responsibilities of the job.
- Item #8: Add Cobalt 60 wires, not to exceed 20 microcuries per wire, for casing and perforation markers. Also, increase Iodine 131 tracers to a maximum of 250 millicuries. Add Iridium 192 tracers with a maximum of 250 millicuries.

We are also enclosing a survey taken approximately 30 days ago at our vacated facility at 2301 South Eastern, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

Please give your earliest attention to this amendment request. If you have any questions, you may contact our consultant, Keith E. Moon, as he has assisted us in the preparation of this amendment request and is authorized to represent us in this matter.
